Reading Progress

We've been emphasizing accuracy and it shows in our Middle of the Year assessments

Kindergarten through 2nd grade data is on target for middle of the year, the target changes a lot for them between the beginning and middle of the year, we were tested early and we anticipate meeting or exceeding our goal of 60% of students making typical or above typical progress on End of Year data. Our interventionists and teachers are running specific groups all over the building to ensure all students are getting what they need to progress. We've noticed a lot of skipping little words and sometimes whole line skipping in some of our really good readers so we're addressing that.

Math Progress

- 7th grade math placement
- 30 students recommended for Honors Math 7... that represents 30% of our 6th grade, this exceeds even the years when we had a Program for Accelerated Learning classes.
- The middle of the year benchmark with online math tool, Imagine Math, showed an average of 110.96 quantile points from the beginning of the year benchmark.
